In August, the <u>Smithtown Library</u> on Long Island suffered damage from flooding.

Library leaders are facing new challenges regarding climate-related events alongside other threats. September is <u>National Preparedness Month</u>, making it an ideal time to re-evaluate or develop strategies and policies for disaster preparedness and response at your library.
